RULES OF THE ESTABLISHMENT

- Punctuality and regular attendance are the first steps to academic success
- I respect the work of my classmates
- I respect the materials of the school
- I tidy my things, my desk and chair at the end of the class
- I respect the premises – no tagging or graffiti
- Smoking is forbidden in front of the school
- No noise in the corridors
- It is forbidden to use the elevator
- Rules of politeness and etiquette must be respected by all pupils in Cours Molière (pupils must stand up when a teacher or member of the administrative staff enters the classroom)
- No physical or verbal violence will be tolerated
- Use of mobile phones, ipods and others MP3 players is forbidden even in the break
- Baseball hats are forbidden. Proper dress code obligatory (tracksuits forbidden)
- Chewing gum, drinks and food are forbidden on the premises
- Violent games and the introduction or possession of dangerous objects and products are forbidden
- Attendance to all exams is obligatory (if a pupil is absent he or she will be obliged to provide a medical certificate or written permission from parents)
- As a prerogative, appointments with doctors and dentists must happen outside of school hours
- Every absence must be imperatively reported to the administration by phone.
- Sport classes are obligatory for everybody (except if presenting a medical certificate or a written note from parents)
- The pupils must behave correctly when outside the establishment (respect of the property/environment)
- Indecent and provocative behavior is forbidden

OBLIGATORY DRESS CODE

Pre-School – Primary – Middle – High-School

Kindergarteners + Primary School students (except 4th Grade/CM1 and 5th Grade/CM2): a uniform is provided by the school. If you want one or plus more, please order on **Bobine.fr**. No earrings, no rings, no bracelets for the boys, no piercings and no religious symbols. Tracksuits, hoodies, baseball caps are forbidden.

4th Grade/CM1 and 5th Grade/CM2 + Middle-School: the obligatory wearing of a navy blazer (for both girls and boys) which must be purchased by the parents BEFORE back to school day.

Middle and High-School:

Boys: slacks or hemmed jeans, in a classic style: grey, black or navy only. A polo, shirt or blouse, in a matching color, covering the belt. PUPILS MUST IMPERATIVELY WEAR SHOES (runners/trainers are forbidden except for sport classes).

Girls: classic pants/slacks or hemmed jeans, in a classic style only. Skirts or dresses that go below the knee. Polo shirt or blouse in a matching colour covering the belt. Cardigan/waistcoat or pullover/jumper and without an inscription. Ballet shoes, mocassins, boots, sandals (trainers are strictly forbidden).

FORBIDDEN: sportswear outside of physical education / Gym class, skirts that are too short, “baggies” and trainers.
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
