• Academic Prefect by Grade:

- A Prefect for each grade from Seconde/10th Grade to Terminale/12th Grade

- A Staff Member responsible for Exams: Mr Ben Messaoud

The Prefect follows the progress of each student individually and ensures that all efforts are made to guarantee his or her success.

• A Highly Qualified Teaching Team: Teachers are recruited for their dynamic teaching skills and their commitment to their students. They can meet with parents by request.

• A Supervisor: He is responsible for the children's discipline so that classes are conducted in a respectful and pleasant environment.

THE MOLIERE METHOD

An experienced educational team train students to learn fundamental knowledge. Thanks to a traditional, demanding method, the curriculum offered by Cours Molière International School follows the guidelines of the French *Education Nationale* and often goes beyond these standards.



• Small-sized Classes: Cours Molière's educational approach distinguishes itself by its emphasis on small size classes. In groups of 20 students, the children grow in a pleasant environment. The personalized attention and the unique learning atmosphere encourage the personal and educational development of every student.

• The Molière Spirit: Similar to English high schools, each student must wear a marine blue blazer. This allows the child to respect him or herself and integrate more easily with the class.

• International Option: For both bilingual students and beginners, English classes will occur in small groups conducted by English-speaking professors to prepare for the Cambridge Exams (IELTS, TOEFL, ...) and/or the High-School Diploma.

- Learning at Cours Molière:

• Specialized attention for non-francophone students: English classes are based on proficiency levels and French classes (Français Langue Etrangère, or F.L.E.) are held with a specialist.

- Sports and Physical Education: Classes at the stadium Léo Lagrange.
- Cultural and educational outings are frequently organized: museums (Louvre, Centre Pompidou, ...), theater, visits to monuments, etc.
- Introductory Chinese classes (option).



TOOLS AND EVALUATIONS

In high school, Cours Molière teaches its students about the pleasure of work well done with its classic learning methods and an effective teaching environment:

• 1 Devoir sur Table (DST) every week, from the Seconde grade to the Terminale grade, in real test conditions for a serious preparation

- 1 grade for every 4 hours of class
- 1 list of grades every six week
- 1 report card every trimester
- In Première: 3 practice exams for the Bac French section
- In Terminale: 3 Bac practice exams during the school year

METHODS OF PAYMENT

The tuition fees, half boarding fees, and annual study hall fees are payable in one of 3 methods:

• Method 1: One-time Payment:

With a 5% reduction on the amount of tuition fees, or euros.

■ <u>Method 2</u>: Registration Check of 2,000 € + 3 Payments (check: August 15th ; November 15th ; February 15th)

• <u>Method 3</u>: Registration Check of 2,000 € + 10 checks (September to June).

Tuition Fee = € + Half Board : € + Study Hall : € Total = € or 10 monthly payments of euros.

IMPORTANT: Registration is definitive only after the school receives the check of 1,500€: registrations are accepted only for one year long. Registrants must pay for the entire school year, even in case of cancellation.
